

## Confirmation Interview Questions

- Details regarding interview will be explained to students in January 2012
  - Interviews must be completed by April 14, 2012
  - Candidate should bring the Spiritual Interview Signature Sheet to the interview
  - Students should be able to verbally discuss their desire for the Sacrament of Confirmation:
1. Tell me what the Sacrament of Confirmation means to you and how it might affect your life.
  2. Tell me what you did for your Catholic Action Service learning experience. How do you see yourself continuing to live a life of service in our parish and the larger community?
  3. What was the most encouraging/positive thing you did during your preparation?
  4. How does God the Holy Spirit received in Confirmation help you to live as a disciple of Jesus?
  5. Describe your prayer life and how your relationship with Jesus has grown. Can you describe why prayer (not just once a day, but throughout the day) is important to your relationship with Jesus?
  6. As you are choosing to be a fully initiated Catholic, tell me what it means to you to be Catholic.
  7. Why does the Church need you and why do you need the Church?
  8. Tell me about a parable or story regarding Jesus that you connected with during your preparation. Tell me why this one.
  9. Can you tell me about an important person in the Bible other than Jesus or God, and how this person is a role model to you?
  10. What did the Apostles do after *they* were filled with the power of the Holy Spirit?
  11. Tell me about your saint name and why you chose this saint. Give me one or two ways you can imitate this saint.
  12. Tell me about your sponsor. How did you choose this person? How is she/he a disciple of Jesus? Tell me what you hope to “copy” from your sponsor (in terms of behavior/service experience).
  13. Tell me how you participate in Sunday Mass EVERY week and on Holy Days. Are you committed to participate in the sacraments of Eucharist every Saturday/Sunday and Reconciliation regularly?
  14. Tell me how you will stay connected to the Catholic Church and the Borromeo community in the next 6 months. During your high school years?
