The theme for this year's Annual Catholic Appeal

In today's first reading, the joy of the first Christians in Jerusalem leaps off the page. "They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God. . ." (Acts 2: 46-47). Similarly, when we *Come Together in Christ* in the Eucharist, we are renewed by our relationship with Christ and feel deep friendship in unity with others. 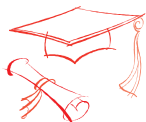
